- 4. Attend and perform at scheduled performances.
 - a. Assist with props.
 - b. Assist with stage transportation and set-up and take-down.
- 5. Find and recommend material for the Puppet Ministry.
- 6. Recommend performance opportunities for the Puppet Ministry.
- 7. Perform individual tasks as assigned by the Puppet Ministry team, for the furthering of team goals.

Time Commitment:

- Monthly time will vary depending on the material, parts assigned, and number of performances.
