Description: The ILS Director serves as a member of the ILS Board of Directors. The ILS Board of Directors is duly elected by the ILS Delegate Assembly. As a member of the ILS Board of Directors, each Director will be responsible for one of the following positions as determined by the Directors at their July organizational meeting.

- 1. Chairman of the ILS Delegate Assembly, Board of Directors, and Executive Committee
- 2. <u>Vice-Chairman</u> of the ILS Delegate Assembly, Board of Directors, and Chairman of the Strategic Planning Committee
- 3. <u>Treasurer</u> of the ILS Delegate Assembly, Board of Directors, and Chairman of the Finance Committee
- 4. <u>Secretary</u> of the ILS Delegate Assembly, Board of Directors, and Chairman of the Personnel Committee
- 5. *Director* and Chairman of the Education Committee
- 6. *Director* and Chairman of the Communication Committee
- 7. *Director* and Chairman of the Property/Grounds Committee
- 8. **Director** and member of the Executive Committee as Chairman-Elect or Treasurer-Elect

Qualifications:

- God has set forth the qualifications for church leaders in 1Timothy 3:8-10, 12-13:
 - "worthy of respect" = has the confidence of the congregation
 - "sincere" = speaks truthfully
 - "not indulging in much wine" = uses alcohol in moderation; self-controlled
 - "not pursuing dishonest gain" = honest
 - "keeps hold of deep truths of the faith" = knowledgeable of the truths of God's Word
 - "keeps hold with a clear conscience" = believes the truth of God's Word
 - "tested" = sets a good example
 - "nothing against them" = good reputation
 - "husband of one wife" = morally upright
 - "manage his children well" = faithful father
 - "manage his household well" = faithful caretaker of one's family
- Demonstrates Christian leadership skills
- Maintains voting membership at either Trinity or Zion congregations

Responsibilities:

- 1. Work diligently as a member of the ILS Board of Directors to help carry out the ministry of Illinois Lutheran Schools by:
 - a. Providing focus and direction for the work of his committee
 - b. Chairing and scheduling all meetings for his committee
 - c. Working closely with the ILS administrative resource(s) associated with his committee
 - d. Properly reporting the work of his committee and providing committee recommendations to the ILS Board of Directors
 - e. Updating the annual task list for the work of his committee
 - f. Appointing as many work groups, action committees, and task forces as necessary to carry out his work

- g. Supporting and enabling his committee to carry out their duties and encourage the development of new thoughts and ideas
- h. Providing training and orientation to members and groups of his committee
- i. Adhering to, updating, and executing the mission/vision of the school
- j. Setting overall operational and ministry priorities
- k. Operating the school on behalf of, and being accountable to the Delegate Assembly, Trinity Ev. Lutheran Church, and Zion Ev. Lutheran Church by:
 - 1) Serving as the corporate body of the school
 - 2) Establishing policy for the school, and maintaining a record of such policies
 - 3) Following adopted budgets and allocating resources (people and money) according to established ministry priorities
 - 4) Holding the ILS Administrator accountable for the daily operation and management of the school
- 2. Attend and participate in all ILS Board of Directors meetings, ILS Delegate Assembly meetings, and complete assigned tasks.
- 3. Actively grow as a leader through:
 - a. Bible study;
 - b. board retreats;
 - c. training opportunities;
 - d. personal reading and other growth opportunities.
- 4. Pray regularly for the members, staff, and ministries of Illinois Lutheran Schools.

Time Commitment:

- 5 hours per month; varies among positions
- 3-year term by election of the ILS Delegate Assembly at their annual meeting

Relationships: The ILS Director is accountable to the ILS Delegate Assembly and the ILS Board of Directors.

Training: All Directors are provided with training through coordination with the Administrator and current Chairman of the ILS Board of Directors.
