Responsibilities:

- 3. Prepare and teach the lessons each Sunday morning that Sunday School is held.
 - a. Use provided materials from the "Dear Christian Friend Bible Story" series from the WELS Jesus Cares Ministries.
- 4. Prepare and present crafts or activities that coordinate with the lessons each week.

Time Commitment

- 1 hour each Sunday, plus 1 hour of preparation time each week
- 1-year commitment, September through May

Relationships: The Jesus Cares Sunday School Teacher works closely with Pastor Italiano, the students' parents, and the students.
