Lost Sheep Ministry Coordinator

Mission Statement: The Lost Sheep Ministry of Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church, out of love and concern for people's spiritual well-being, contacts members who have been absent from worship services for a period of greater than three months in an effort to bring them back home to the Trinity family.

Description: The Lost Sheep Ministry Coordinator coordinates the ministry so that the appropriate members are contacted to invite them back to worship and/or to ascertain the following:

- Why has the member been absent from worship?
- Does Trinity meet their worship needs? If not, why not?
- What improvements can Trinity make that would prevent the loss of members from worship?
- Are there significant problems that need to be addressed? If so, how can Trinity help?

Qualifications:

- Spiritually active male member of Trinity Ev. Lutheran Church.
- Awareness and understanding of the congregation and its members.
- Spiritually mature (Not new to the Word).

Responsibilities:

- 1. Obtain a list of people from the Board of Elders each month.
- 2. Schedule meetings with Contactors, and work with Contactors to determine contacts to be made.
- 3. Report to Board of Elders any circumstances that may need immediate attention.
- 4. Make contacts by phone, card, electronically, or in person in an effort to guide individuals back home to Trinity.
- 5. Relay any necessary information to the ministry staff and Board of Elders.

Time Commitment:

- 4-6 hours per month
- Minimum 1-year commitment, reviewed annually

Relationships: The Lost Sheep Ministry Coordinator works under the direction of the Administrative Pastor and the Board of Elders and works with the Contactors and members of the congregation.

Training: The Lost Sheep Coordinator will be trained by the Administrative Pastor.
