Sunday School **Team Leader**

Mission Statement: The Sunday School program of Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church, grounded in God's Word, educates, equips, and encourages all children 3 years old through Grade 8 so that they may know God's grace and grow in His love.

Description: The Sunday School Team Leader is responsible for coordinating and overseeing a team of Station Leaders (for the story, craft, and activity stations) and Shepherds (to lead each group of children to and from each station).

Qualifications:

- Spiritually mature
- Active, committed member of Trinity Ev. Lutheran Church
- Consistent in walk with Christ
- Ability to lead others
- Knowledge of Lutheran doctrine and Trinity's teachings
- Completed and passed the online background screening process

Responsibilities:

- 1. Read and follow the Child Protection Policy.
- 2. Prior to the opening of the Sunday School year, put together a team of Station Leaders and Shepherds.
- 3. Be in open communication with the Sunday School Coordinator.
- 4. On one designated Sunday of each month, coordinate and oversee the functions of the team during the Sunday School hour.
 - a. Make sure all team members are present and have proper materials.
 - b. Take and record attendance and collect offerings.
 - c. Unlock and lock Sunday School facility.
 - d. Put Sunday School sign outside.
- 5. If a member of the team cannot be present for an assigned Sunday, find a substitute.

Time Commitment:

- 2 hours per month
- 1-year commitment, September through May (one Sunday per month)

Relationships: The Sunday School Team Leader works with the Sunday School Coordinator and with the Station Leaders and Shepherds of his or her team.

Training: The Sunday School Team Leader is trained by the Coordinator, who will make sure the Team Leaders understand all aspects of the ministry and the responsibilities of being a Team Leader.
