Responsibilities:

- 1. Read and follow the Child Protection Policy.
- 2. Communicate with teens and general public.
 - a. Communicate all upcoming TTM events to teen members via church bulletin and newsletter, email, text messages and social networks in a timely manner.
 - b. Arrange for newspaper advertising of TTM events.
 - c. Develop and maintain TTM web presence.
- 3. Communicate with TTM team.
 - a. Track attendance of teens at all TTM events.
 - b. Prepare attendance reports and present to leadership team.
 - c. Take minutes at leadership team meetings.
- 4. Attend TTM leadership team meetings.
- 5. Encourage TTM volunteers in their duties.
- 6. Train incoming Communication Coordinator.

Time Commitment:

- Approximately 4 6 hours per month
- 2-year commitment beginning in October

Relationships: The Communication Coordinator works closely with the rest of the TTM leadership team.

Training: The Communication Coordinator will be trained by the outgoing Communication Coordinator. Additional resources are available through the ministerial staff and church web master.
