## **Responsibilities:**

- 1. Read and follow the Child Protection Policy.
- 2. Choose crafts for VBS week.
- 3. Implement the crafts with the children during VBS week.
- 4. Set up site in preparation for each day.
- 5. Clean up site after each day.
- 6. Work with Shepherds and Helpers to manage the classroom.
- 7. Attend scheduled planning meetings.

## Time Commitment:

- Assuming a late July VBS week: May, 3 hours choosing craft projects and ordering materials; June, 2 hours making sure materials and any additional items are ordered and available; July, 4 hours setting up for VBS week, attending planning meeting; VBS week, 25 hours
- 1-year commitment

**Relationships:** The Vacation Bible School Arts and Crafts Leader will work closely with the Board of Family Ministry Spiritual Advisor; Vacation Bible School Superintendent; Vacation Bible School Shepherds and Helpers; the children attending VBS.

**Training:** A craft leader's guide comes with the VBS materials. The Vacation Bible School Superintendent works closely with the Arts and Crafts Leader, and the spiritual advisor is available to assist and support.
