Vacation Bible School Bible Story Leader

Description: The Vacation Bible School Bible Story Leader oversees the planning and direction of the Bible story station of Vacation Bible School as well as the day-to-day operations of the Bible story station during VBS week.

Qualifications:

- Good people skills
- Organized
- Mature member of Trinity Ev. Lutheran Church
- Able to teach multiple ages of children
- Able to properly discriminate law and gospel
- Able to manage a classroom
- Has a heart for children
- Cheerful
- Completed and passed the online background screening process if age 18 or over

Responsibilities:

1. Read and follow the Child Protection Policy.
2. Prepare for teaching the Bible story through advance Bible study and gathering of necessary materials.
3. Teach the prepared Bible story during VBS week.
4. Attend scheduled planning meetings.

Time Commitment:

- 8 hours of preparation per story, plus 5 hours per day of VBS; the leader may commit to one or more days of VBS
- 1-year commitment

Relationships: The Vacation Bible School Bible Story Leader will work closely with the Board of Family Ministry Spiritual Advisor; Vacation Bible School Superintendent; Vacation Bible School Shepherds and Helpers; the children attending VBS.

Training: A Bible story leader's guide for each grade level comes with the materials. The Vacation Bible School Superintendent and the spiritual advisor are available to assist and support.
