Women's Ministry Bible Class Leader

Mission Statement: The Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church Women's Ministry, rooted in Christ, emphasizes women ministering to women, for the purpose of equipping and encouraging women so they can evangelize in their homes, in the church, in the community and around the world.

Description: The Women's Bible Class Leader thoroughly studies and prepares materials, provides a comfortable environment, and facilitates group discussion in order to help women grow in their knowledge of the Bible and also apply the lessons to their lives.

Qualifications:

- Spiritually mature, committed female member of Trinity Ev. Lutheran Church or other WELS church
- Consistent in walk with Christ
- Faithful, available, and teachable
- Has a shepherding heart
- Is able to teach and develop others
- Approved by the Administrative Pastor
- Has a servant leadership style, which is influential in nature, rather than authoritative

Responsibilities:

- 1. Facilitate group discussion during Bible class.
- 2. Provide a warm and sensitive environment in which the Bible class members feel welcomed and loved.
- 3. Study the material ahead of time in preparation for leading the class.
- 4. Maintain study focus and tactfully keep others on track during Bible class.
- 5. Mentor and encourage the women in her class.
- 6. Grow as a leader through Bible study, retreats, training opportunities, and personal reading and growth opportunities.
- 7. Pray regularly for the women in the class.

Time Commitment:

- Preparation time for class and length of course material will vary depending on the individual situation.
- Leaders are asked to lead a minimum of one class per year.

Relationships: The Women's Ministry Bible Class Leader works with the Women's Ministry Leadership Development Coordinator and the Women's Ministry team.

Training: The Bible Class Leader will be mentored by previous Bible Class Leaders. She will also be trained in a Bible Class Leaders workshop.
