**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF SILT BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
ADOPTING THE UPDATED GARFIELD COUNTY MULTI-  
JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN (HMP) 2022**

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 was signed in to law on October 30, 2000, placing new emphasis on state and local mitigation planning for natural hazards and requiring communities to adopt a hazard mitigation action plan to be eligible for pre-disaster and post-disaster federal funding for mitigation purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, a Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan was prepared by Garfield County, Colorado, with assistance from JEO Consulting Group, Inc. of Wahoo, NE.; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the mitigation plan was to lessen the effects of disasters by increasing the disaster resistance of the county and participating jurisdictions located therein by identifying the hazards that affect the Town of Silt and prioritize mitigation strategies to reduce potential loss of life and property damage from those hazards; and

**WHEREAS**, the Colorado Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency reviewed and approved the Garfield County Hazard Mitigation Plan Update as of August 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, FEMA regulations require documentation that the plan has been formally adopted by the governing body of the Town of Silt in the form of a resolution and further requesting approval of the plan at the Federal Level.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF SILT, COLORADO**, does herewith adopt the FEMA approved Garfield County Hazard Mitigation Plan Update in its entirety.
