DIRECTOR OF MUSIC MINISTRIES (Revised 03/7/2017)

POSITION SUMMARY:

The position of Director of Music Ministries seeks to focus on and enhance the worship experiences through coordination of the total music program. The position is part-time and reports to the Senior Pastor.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Direct, rehearse, and provide keyboard accompaniment for the Sanctuary Choir.
- 2. Rehearse and provide keyboard accompaniment for the Praise Team and Contemporary Service.
- 3. Provide keyboard accompaniment for the Contemplative Service.
- 4. Supervise the Contemporary Music Leader and the Contemporary Music Assistants
- 5. Plan and direct Bell Choir(s).
- 6. Engage guest soloists and performers for special music programs and worship services.
- 7. Assist choir members in preparation for solos.
- 8. Provide information for the church bulletin each week.
- 9. Plan and prepare for special programs during the year.
- 10. Select appropriate hymns and special music for worship services in coordination and with the ministers.
- 11. Order music supplies needed to support the total music program of the church.
- 12. Insure that instruments are properly tuned and maintained.
- 13. Meet with the ministers on a regular basis to plan both long and short range needs of the church.
- 14. Perform at weddings and other activities requiring the services of an organist.
- 15. Procure adequate substitutes for sickness and vacation.

QUALITIES:

- 1. Spiritual leader, capable of using his/her spiritual gifts to express a personal faith in Jesus Christ.
- 2. A leader with networking, organizing, and delegating skills.
- 3. A person sensitive to the mission and vision of Westminster Presbyterian Church and able to express that mission and vision through the musical ministries of the church.
- 4. A person with the ability to inspire, recruit, and train talented team member from the congregation.

EXPECTATIONS:

- 1. Have a strong personal relationship with Jesus Christ.
- 2. Have strong interpersonal skills with youth and adults.
- 3. Be a team player.
- 4. Maintain high professional level of musicianship.
- 5. Attend and participate in Worship Commission meetings as scheduled.
- 6. Attend and participate in staff meetings and retreats as scheduled.

WORKING RELATIOONSHIPS:

- 1. The Director of Music Ministries reports directly to:
 - a. The Senior Pastor (as Head of Staff) through ongoing informal communication and regular meetings.
 - b. The Worship Commission.
