I'm Waiting in the Tokyo airport for a flight to


Guam. I left Houston July 1, 2014 and rode for almost 14 hours to get here. A 5 hour wait and then a 4 hour flight to Guam. Then to bed. I AM requested prayer for Pastor [Richard Robeson](#) and me as we minister in the Philippines.



Thursday July 3rd, 3 PM at Guam Airport

The beginning of another adventure with God's Holy Spirit travelling to Manila, Philippine Islands. via Tokyo and Guam. I changed my flight when I realized that the flight I was on to Manila via Hawaii and Guam was way overbooked and I would not get on. Dean Lange has taught me to look for other ways to get there so I did. The standby way for International travel is guaranteed to improve your prayer life. I sat at the gate and prayed and watched the standby list and prayed and watched the standby list and prayed. I received the last Business class seat 11K and was the last one to board the plane. 14 hours later I was in Tokyo and waiting at the gate for Guam and yes praying again. I was number 1 on the list. This time I got 21C exit row with more leg room. But I'm on and going to Guam. PTL! I had made a reservation at a hotel so when I arrived in Guam and got my luggage I took a cab to the hotel. As is my practice I like to share the gospel with cab drivers and I did so again. Salvador Imbat received Christ as his savior at the hotel after we unloaded the luggage. I had only been in Guam for 30 minutes and was able to lead someone to Christ!

I was really tired and went to my room for some rest. I started the morning at 7 AM by going downstairs and asked the clerk if there was a restaurant close by. "Yes", she said, "There is a Subway next door." So I went to Subway for breakfast. I noticed that Justin who had waited on me was alone and I shared the gospel with him and he gladly received Christ as his Lord and Savior. What a great start for today, thank you Holy Spirit. I then went back to the hotel and shared with the desk clerk and Lanalyn Tapang bowed her head and prayed to receive the gift of eternal life and be "born again". Wow I've not been here 12 hours yet and God has allowed me to see 3 pray to receive Christ as savior. I had to check out at 11 AM.



I checked into the airport and walked towards the gate but it was not open yet. I spoke with Marie Daria a young 23 year old woman at a concession stand who was very happy to be “born again” into God’s family. Four souls being saved already affirmed to me how plentiful the harvest field is. I am honored to be an Ambassador for Jesus Christ.

I was able to make contact with the pastor at Calvary Chapel in Guam. He is a friend of Robert Lemley. I was already checked in when he asked me if we could go to lunch. It was about 1:30 PM and I said sure my flight is not till 7 PM. He said he would be at the airport about 2 – 2:30 PM and would pick me up. Well a problem arose and we were not able to meet. I hope to spend about 3 days in Guam on my way home. We will meet then.



I am looking forward to meeting up with Pastor Richard Robeson at the airport in Manila. My flight arrives at 9:30 PM and his at 10 or 11 PM.

Friday July 4, 2014 5:20 PM at Mission House in Santa Rosa

It’s been an exciting 22 hours. I arrived on schedule at 9:30 PM and waited for Richard who arrived at 11 PM. During that time I was messaging with Elmo Macalintal from Jesus Christ Victorious Church (JCVC) and Jill Harvell, our IMB missionary there. Richard had arranged with Jill for us to stay at New Tribes Mission house for the night and a driver to pick us up at the Manila airport. I followed Jill’s instructions and went to the pic

Saturday July 5th 11:00 PM


I had a wonderful evening with my friends from Jesus Christ Victorious Church (JCVC.). The young people came at 7 PM to begin practice for Sunday's service. Earlier I spent about 3 hours with 5 young Vietnamese students. The men have been with us both last November when I was here with Pastor Richard and in February when I was here with Roy Mimms. They are students at the Bible College in Antipoli. The girls have traveled here from Ho Chi Minh city and have been here for only 2 weeks. They have come for the conference. I learned from Pastora Ha that more than 40 are coming from Vietnam . The number could reach 60 or more she said. So, they informed Richard and me tonight that they are moving us to a hotel so they can house as many Vietnamese here as they could.

Also they reminded us that we will have wi-fi at the hotel to better communicate with home. Two students are translating a Power point lesson for me into Vietnamese. *Church Sent*, a message that shows God has always "Sent" to accomplish His will. God sent Angels, Moses, Abraham, the Prophets, John the Baptist, Jesus Christ, the Holy Spirit, the Church, and you and me. I have had time while in rest mode to read Matthew, Mark & Luke and the Holy Spirit has really impressed me that NOTHING IS IMPOSSIBLE WITH GOD! So I just finished a side by side table with 11 verses that declare this.

I know that I know that I know that God has something big for Richard and me to be a part of as He uses us to minister to all who come to the meetings. The first group of 40 are to arrive on Monday at 4 AM. Classes are scheduled for each day thru Friday. Saturday will be tourist events and Sunday is anniversary for JCVC church.

Monday July 7, 2014, 10 AM

Wow, where to begin. Yesterday was an awesome service at JCVC. Pastor Richard and Elmo both delivered strong messages on obedience and seeking God's wisdom and hiding God's word in your heart. The praise team both music and dance was incredible. We had three saved at the morning service. In the afternoon Richard and I had the youth for almost 3 hours. We shared with them and I taught the class on Evangelism 101. I gave them a giant evangel



cube and we demonstrated

how to use it.

Pastora Ha told us that they were going to move us to a hotel because 60 or more are



coming to the conference from Vietnam and many of them will be sleeping at the church. So we are now at a real nice comfortable hotel.

This morning Richard and I met for breakfast. I led 6 hotel employees to the Lord, printed out and gave them their Spiritual Birth Certificates and when I went down stairs to deliver them they told me that they thanked God that He had sent me to them.

I AM amazed that they knew that they had experienced a “divine appointment”. They were right. God did send me to them. Who is He sending you to? Aframe, a young business man, wanted to be born again also after he witnessed the joy of the others.

Monday, July 7, 2014 PM The conference starts tomorrow. Richard and I are prayed up and ready. I AM in awe of the power of God; 78 saved while waiting for



the conference made up of reps from Vietnam,

Message from one of our contacts in the Philippines:

This is my first time I have gone to prison with

my husband Greg. I AM sure all the prisoners think I AM crazy.



I cried most of the time we were there. I cried as all 53 came in and greeted me. I cried when they were singing Praise songs, I cried during the Bible study as they were reading the Word in unison, and I cried as 15 were baptized. I really cried when they had to help an older man who had a stroke get down in the swimming pool. I cried as I gave out reading glasses and flip flops and did not have enough, cried as I watched them scoff down the pancit and bread knowing they were still hungry. I cried thinking of the 50 families whose lives have been affected as their sons, husbands, brothers and fathers who are serving time there. So thankful for Greg ministering to this group of men and giving them hope in Jesus!!!! **Jill Harvell, International Mission Board Missionary**
