

11. Psalms 119: 81-88

- a. **Principle #11: Rule #7: Wait on the Coach. Don't do anything unless and until He tells you to.**
- b. **Practice #11: Keep your eyes on the coach.**
- c. **Explanation: In life there are a lot of distractions and a lot of people who will want to distract you. You need to focus on the coach. Watch him and wait on him. He will tell you whether or not you need to go or stay or do anything at all. Peter took his eyes off the coach and almost drowned. He was doing the impossible. He was walking on water. When he took his eyes off Jesus he realized he was in deep water and he began to sink. Jesus didn't let him go under. If we keep our eyes on the coach he will tell us what to do if anything. If we take our eyes of him we will realize we our in deep water and in over our heads. We will be consumed with worry and anxiety and we will start to drown. He won't let us sink, but why not keep our gaze on him at all times and not be distracted?**
