- ❖ **Principle #20: *The Coach is always fair!***
- ❖ **Practice #20: Let the Coach deal with the referees and missed or unfair calls. He is able to argue your case.**
- ❖ **Explanation: The other team will try to distract you by yelling foul when it is fair or complaining over some minor detail to try to distract or discourage you. Let the Coach handle the rules and the umpires. He knows what really happened and he will eventually make all things fair and right. Don't you risk getting thrown out of the game or losing your focus due to the distractions of the details of life and its unfairness. Let God handle the details and the seemingly unfair way life treats you. In the long run He will argue your case and straighten out any and all injustices.**
- ❖ **Application: How did I avoid getting tripped up this week by allowing the Coach (God) to deal with the injustices and the little irritations of my life?**
