

4. Psalm 119: 25-32

- ❖ Principle #4: **The Commitment.** *I am ready and willing to play. I commit to play by the rules. Help me not to cheat even when I don't know I'm cheating.*
- ❖ Practice #4: I need to focus not on winning or losing or even being the best, I need to focus on obediently learning how to play.
- ❖ Explanation: As I learn to play the game, I desperately want to win even if it means cheating and cutting corners to do so. Since I am just learning the rules, I may cheat and take short cuts even when I am not aware of it. The coach and the Holy Spirit needs to let me know somehow when I am not doing it right so I can correct my behavior. After all practice does not make perfect, perfect practice makes perfect.
