- a. **Principle #8: Rule #4: *All the answers to the meaning of life are found in God's word.***
- b. **Practice #8: If you want to find meaning in your life look in the Bible.**
- c. **Explanation: Solomon who was the wisest man who ever lived said all of life is meaningless in the Book of Ecclesiastes. The only thing he found that was meaningful at all was to obey God and keep His commandments. That was the only thing that gave meaning to life, and he tried everything you and I will ever think of. If you want to find meaning for your life and make sense out of your existence, look in the Bible. Now looking in the Bible doesn't mean just reading it or meditating on it, it means search the scriptures. Get yourself a concordance and search for what you do not understand. If you look diligently God will reveal to you the meaning. This will keep you from looking for truth in all the wrong places. Turn to the Bible first.**
