

ARE YOU EXPERIENCING BURNOUT?

Tapping the Source of Power

Central Truth: Perseverance and endurance are not enough!

Do you ever have a day when you just feel you are used up? Have you ever hit a time when you realize that there is just nothing more to give? These feelings have not been uncommon in any time; however, they appear especially prevalent in ours.

One of the current words used to describe that feeling is "burn out." In other times it was just called being spiritually exhausted, tired or weary. There are a myriad of camps and retreat centers which address nothing else.

Why do you suppose we have fallen prey to this particular malady so frequently today?

My best guess is that many of us who are Christians have lost sight of the real goal. Human beings often need to be able to have an end in sight if we are to retain our enthusiasm. The work of Christian service is never easy. It is sometimes filled with disappointment and hardship. Without a clear view of a finish line, the race becomes too difficult. The Apostle Paul could speak of finishing the race as he neared the end of his life because he knew where the finish line was. He had continued to run, in good

times and in bad, because the goal was never in doubt.

Paul also knew how difficult the race could be. So the determined apostle also encouraged other runners with words like, "But as for you, brethren, do not grow weary of doing good" (II Thessalonians 3:13 NASB). He also encouraged the Christians of Galatia with these words: "Let us not lose heart in doing good, for in due time we will reap if we do not grow weary" (Galatians 6:9).

Jesus spoke of being "weary and heavyladen" with sin and teachings that exhausted and defeated them: promised His followers relief and blessing (Matthew 11:28). Paul wrote to those who were worn out doing good. We will reap in due time if we do not exit the race. The light at the end of the tunnel, the finish line, the reward for continuing, are all more than phrases to be quoted; they are also promises from God Himself. The writer of Hebrews continues this same encouragement with these words: "For consider Him who has endured such hostility by sinners against Himself, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart" (Hebrews 12:3). Keep Jesus before you as an antidote against that weariness and the resultant hopelessness of forgetting your goal.

While looking to the finish and contemplating the reward is certainly motivating, we must never forget that the deeper motive of our "doing good." That cardinal motive of all good things must be love. The book of Revelation calls Christians to "perseverance and endurance." Jesus also reminds us in His message to the churches in the book of Revelation that perseverance and endurance are not enough. God's Son reminded the church in Ephesus of this truth: "... you have perseverance and have endured for My name's sake, and have not grown weary. But I have this

against you, that you have left your first love. Therefore remember from where you have fallen, and repent and do the deeds you did at first; or else I am coming to you and will remove your lampstand out of its place—unless you repent' (Revelation 2:3-5).

When we are motivated out of guilt, competitiveness, fear, or anger, we burn out more quickly and more completely. This is especially true when we feel like we didn't get the "big pay off" for doing what we did. We forget that such motivation is based on our power and our motives and not God's grace and power. Like Paul, we need to be compelled by the love of Christ — love for Christ and love like Christ's (II Corinthians 5:14). So "not losing heart" is an integral part of the journey; however, unless it is motivated by love, "it profits nothing" (I Corinthians 13:3).

Run the race with perseverance.

Run and do not lose heart.

Run in expectation of the finish. Run always compelled by love!

I'm not sure where you are on your journey. I hope you have learned that quick fixes are nearly always wrong and that shortcuts to spirituality are nearly always Satan's traps. Instead, enjoy the journey. Speak openly to God about the matters of your heart. Look for the wide sweep of your story and remain faithful for the long haul. And when it is hard to find the words to express your joys, sorrows, reservations, frustrations, delights, praise, loneliness, confidence. and fear? Open the Psalms and let them help you pour your heart, in faith, to the God of the beginning, the end, and the journey. The world is in challenging times. Reports from around the world remind us of radical groups that attack Christians. burn church buildings, and even murder believers in the middle of the night. While a world wide problem, it is especially acute in

Africa where people have been so open to the Gospel of Christ.

We have read reports of a missionary imprisoned for months on trumped up charges that could cost him his life.

At McClain Ministries, we are urging you to encourage your church leaders, your group Bible study, your Sunday school class and your friends to devote quality time in prayer for all believers everywhere who profess their faith under threat of harm. Pray for God's Word, grace and love to triumph over hatred, brutality and death. Many centuries ago the saying was born: "The blood of the martyrs is the seed of the Church." While true, let's pray that the Gospel can triumph without the loss of life in our time.

Those of us who can freely declare our allegiance to God must give thanks and recognize that our blessings are given to us to bless others, especially those facing hardship because of their faith. Make a commitment personally to a specific nation where persecution now exists. Pray for it every day. Learn all you can about that country. Pray for the political leaders, the missionaries, the ministers, the church leaders, the Christians and their children by name. Ask God's power and grace to triumph through them even through these difficult times.

The book of Acts ends with Paul imprisonment. Yet the last word of Luke's story is the adverb "unhinderedly." Luke's point, not even persecution and the threat of death can hinder the liberating power of the Gospel. As Paul reminded Timothy (II Timothy 2:9), even though Christians may be imprisoned and in chains, "God's word is not chained!" Let's pray that His people will not be either!

Tapping the Source of Power



Central Truth: The Lord is still out there in the multitudes!

The sun rises and the sun sets. It makes its rounds each day. What has it seen? Though there is a great difference in the scenes over which it passes on its daily course, there are patterns which do not seem to change. In every country there are the rich and the poor. When Jesus said, "The poor your have with you always," (Mark 14:7) He was not limiting His pronouncement to Judea. It was a fact that would span both distance and time. Even as the Rich Man was little aware and undoubtedly unmoved by the plight of Lazarus, sitting in misery at his gate and desiring only the crumbs that fell from his table, many today with wealth to spare look the other way when poverty shows its hollow eves and bloated bellies.

We would not deny that there are those who constantly and sacrificially pursue the benefit of the poor, but they find great resistance as they seek aid from a world blinded by its own selfishness and dying from its own overindulgence. One of the least watched programs on television is one which graphically portrays the plight of those human wretches huddled together in desperate situations, teetering on the brink of starvation. Hollow-eved and bone-thin.

they are unwanted reminders of man's inhumanity to his fellow man. Those who with loud cries denounce the atrocities of the prison camps of World War II, turn a deaf ear to the cries of hungry children in an unfair and uncaring world.

In the United States, wearing bracelets with the letters WWJD on them became a fad. These initials stood for the phrase, "What Would Jesus Do?" Many are reminded of the acts of morality which Jesus showed by His life of purity, but few appear to be stirred by His most pointed judgment. Depicting the final judgment, Jesus sums up the lives of those blessed by the Father and those cursed for eternity. Their acts bear little resemblance to the mighty works of holiness so touted by many religious leaders in our day. Rather, His judgment fell on the simplest of things. "I was hungry, I was thirsty, I was a stranger, I was naked, I was sick, I was in prison." Heaven and hell hung on how one responded to these situations. Did they help or did they ignore? That was the test. The protest from both sides was, "When did we see You . . . ?" And the Lord's response was, "It was what you did to the least of these that was done to Me."

It still is! The Lord is still out there in the multitudes, hungry and faint and poor. Have you fed Him? Did you give Him a drink? How would He judge you if you stood before Him today?

As long as there are people doing without the basic necessities of life in our world, godliness demands contentment and gratitude of us. It demands that we praise God for all the good things that He gives us, and it demands that we learn to say "no" to that voice inside that continually demands more, and better, and to eventually choke it down. If we have learned the habit of avarice, godliness demands repentance. And if we have been blinded and deafened by our plenty to the crushing needs of so many around us,

godliness demands that we open our eyes and ears.

The fact is that there are just too many people in our world without the basic essentials of life. For a few of us in one of the most prosperous countries on the planet, how can we be anything but content? We must be content, because discontent dishonors the God who has given us so much. And beyond that, we must be content because greed leads us to spend our lives enriching ourselves while ignoring the predicament of people who really know what want is. When we're content, we see how much we have and are willing to help those who have less. When we're not, all we can see is what we want and feel so sure that we need.



Is it me, or is there something just vaguely embarrassing about the excitement with which the rest of the world accepts what America throws away? What if, instead of our cast-offs and hand-me-downs, the Body of Christ committed to generosity that was a bit more sacrificial? What do you think pleases the Lord more: a church full of well-dressed, well-groomed, people in new clothes and new cars? Or a church full of people — content with what they have been given — who have put off buying new clothes and new cars so that they can share their abundance with folks who don't have the essentials?

I think I know the answer to that, and I think you do, too.

The sun still rises, the sun still sets and in its course it passes over the acts of man, but it is not what the sun sees that we must be concerned about, it is what the Son sees, and He sees it all!

Scriptural References:

Command those who are rich in this present world not to be arrogant nor to put their hope in wealth, which is so uncertain, but to put their hope in God, who richly provides us with everything for our enjoyment. Command them to do good, to be rich in good deeds, and to be generous and willing to share. In this way they will lay up treasure for themselves as a firm foundation for the coming age, so that they may take hold of the life that is truly life (I Timothy 6:17-19)

FROM MEDITATION TO MANIFESTATION

I am in the process of completing a new manual entitled "From Meditation To Manifestation." Here is Chapter Fifteen:

THE TRUE MEANING OF LIFE

never ends. Even when the cycle of physical life on Earth has been transcended and we progress to the primary school of life, the path God our Divine Creator is long, but much more tranquil peaceful and harmonious, with none of the trials and tribulations experienced within the physical Earth life system. It is the destiny, and should be the primary objective of every without exception person graduate from the kindergarten of Earth with honors in order to progress to the next phase of Divine education. Consider the situation from the perspective of the other person or people involved and ask yourself what you would do in these same circumstances. The ego is a very powerful adversary and will always cause you to insist that you are right and everyone else must therefore be wrong. This is just one

reason why it is so exceptionally important to transcend the influence of ego and to assume full control over your own mind and actions at all times.

The ego will revel in causing trouble whenever and wherever it possibly can, and must never be allowed to do so. If the uncontrolled ego is allowed to exert its influence in this way, the lessons will not be learned and the future will be adversely affected.

There is quite simply no avoiding the lessons needing to be learned. If every human being knew the glories that await them further along the path, beyond this life cycle no person would delay for a moment in learning and practicing the glories of life. It would become a passionate desire to learn the physical lessons of the kindergarten of Earth and to progress to the glories, splendors and magnificence of the next phase of life. And you notice, I say. the next phase of life, not death.

Each situation you are presented with should be faced with complete confidence, always knowing beyond any doubts whatsoever that you are an immortal Spiritual being, a Son or Daughter of God made in the true Spiritual image of God and nothing can ever harm you.

Never miss an opportunity to help others or to provide selfless service; opportunities presented each and every day if only you watch vigilant for them.

Always give thanks for every single such opportunity arising in your life; thank God, as well as those many unseen beings of the universe who dedicate themselves to your well-being and progression out of Pure Unconditional Love and who help you in the process of learning and practicing the true meaning of life.

Our goal is fourfold:

- 1. Build a school that includes 4 classrooms, 2 bathrooms and 1 administration office at a cost of approximately \$25,000.
 - 2. Provide 300 Girl's Secondary School Scholarships at a cost of \$117,000
 - 3. Supply 160 benches for the new school at a cost of \$6400
 - 4. Supply 100 benches for existing schools at a cost of \$4000
