

Tapping the Source of Power

Central Truth: We should plug into our spiritual source of power and just make it happen!

Sometimes I tend to look to my past and remember "the good old days" and compare them to today. I remember churches where I have worshipped, friendships I have had, works in which I have been involved, and think, "I sure wish I could go back there again" or "I sure wish I could be like that again." I've been guilty of sometimes doing this to the point that I forget my present journey or overlook the opportunities in the place where I am.

If we believe that God opens doors and directs steps, then why are we so unhappy with where we are? Why in our hearts do we turn back to Egypt?

The Israelites remembered the good things they experienced in Egypt to the point of forgetting how bad things were for them as slaves there. They rebelled against God and where He was directing their journey. In fact, they rejected the journey, they rejected where they were and they ended up rejecting God's instructions and in that rejected God.

Contrast that with the description of the Apostle Paul and his struggle in life:

"I don't mean to say that I have already achieved these things or that I have already reached perfection! But I keep working toward that day when I will finally be all that Christ Jesus saved me for and wants me to be. No, dear brothers and sisters, I am still not all I should be, but I am focusing all my energies on this one thing: Forgetting the past and looking forward to what lies ahead, I strain to reach the end of the race and receive the prize for which God, through Christ Jesus, is calling us up to heaven" (Philippians 3:12-14).

The next time we are tempted to compare the present with the past, might I suggest that we stop ourselves and try to refocus on the present. We have so many blessings, but we also have so much work to do. Let's focus on making these days "the good old days." Let's build relationships and churches and love the way we should and stop turning back to Egypt in our hearts. Let us do as Paul did. Let's forget the past, look forward, and strain to reach the prize God has for us!

The best way to improve the past is to live the way God wants us to live today, rooted in the moment and living for God — in service to others and in service to Him.

Tapping the Source of Power

Central Truth: Spiritual growth is an ongoing transition from bondage to freedom in prayer and in every other aspect of life.

Countless have been the times that I have heard (and probably said) something to the effect: "This is the darkest day of my life."

For starters, the "dark day" is a profoundly good thing. It is an ongoing spiritual process in which we are liberated from attachments and compulsions and empowered to live more freely. Of course, this doesn't mean that the darkness isn't painful — for loss and grief do bring pain. The good news is that in obscurity and uncertainty — two realities most Christians do everything to avoid — God is present.

And not only is he present, God eventually

brings about a dawn; a dawn that is characterized by liberation of love, deepening of faith, gratitude and awareness of our union with Him.

To guide us toward this union with God to the love we most desire — we must be taken where we could not and would not go on our own. And though the 'perceived' darkness can be quite troublesome and frustrating, it is when we cannot chart our own course that we become vulnerable to God's protection and the darkness can even become a guiding light.

Thankfully, though the "darkness" is healing and liberating and humbling, it is not an end in and of itself. It is rather an ongoing transition from bondage to freedom in prayer and in every other aspect of life. In other words, one of the greatest fruits that comes from the "darkness" experience is the Spirit's nudge — which sometimes feels like a "yank" — to receive the offer of contemplative prayer as a way of life. Of course, in our fast-paced, busy, compulsive society, few willingly choose contemplation, much less silence. But as life comes to a stop — whether through loss, fatigue, failed expectations or a gnawing sense that life is meaningless — God, through the "darkness," calls us to relinguish our idolatries and see that He is closer to us than we think.

As we — or others we love — go through the dark days, two questions seem especially appropriate: "Do you really want to go back to the way things were?" and "What then do you most deeply desire?" It is through those challenging times that you can affirm that it is indeed when life seems darkest and silent, that you begin to experience how close the love of Christ really is and how our ultimate vocation in life is to share this love with the world!

HISTORY OF VOTING

1776 When this country announced its independence from Britain, voting rights were based on property ownership. This typically meant that those voting were white males over the age of 21 of Protestant religion.

1787 In the newly drafted Constitution, states were given the power to set voting mandates and most were still favorable to white males who owned property.

1830 Many states had dropped religion and property ownership as requirements for voting and with such a large percentage of the population at the polls, political parties were beginning to develop.

1868 The 14th Amendment recognizes African Americans as citizens, giving them the right to vote. However, state officials continue attempts to deny this right.




1870 African Americans were given the right to vote in the 15th Amendment. It prohibited any state or local government from denying that right.

1890 Wyoming becomes the first state to recognize women's right to vote and provide for it in a state constitution.

1913 Voting power is expanded with 17th Amendment, calling for the popular election of US. senators.

1920 The 19th Amendment was added to the Constitution, giving women across the nation the right to vote.



1940 Congress recognizes Native Americans as citizens. However, it wasn't until 1947 that all states granted them the right to vote.

1964 The 24th Amendment declares that no person should be denied the right to vote because they cannot pay a "poll tax."

1965 An amendment to the Voting Rights Act bans the use of literacy tests, poll taxes and other obstacles designed to keep people from voting.

1971 The voting age is lowered to 18.

(II Corinthians 12:8-10) God calls us to look outward and upward to the limitless possibilities He has placed before His children. Trouble enough awaits those who walk this path on the way to glory. We will all stumble and fall now and then. However, the secret is to keep our eyes open to the vision of the Almighty who will always be there to pick us up and lead us on to victory. So I say to you today:

REFLECTIVE PERSONALITIES

(Law of Attraction)

During your sojourn you will invariably encounter people that you do not "like" for one reason or another.

You might for example think that someone you meet is "arrogant" or a manager at work is "egotistical", your bank manager is "aloof", a relative is "argumentative", a friend is "greedy" and so on.

Sometimes you might confront the person, other times you might talk about him or her with others, and you might wish to "get even".

The truth is this - dealing with a very wide array of people and circumstances is one of the most important reasons we are here in the first place, and one of the greatest virtues of this physical world of matter and its infinite variety.

In this physical World we meet and must deal with numerous different people, and overcome numerous situations, each one of which is a valuable learning opportunity - of course whether this opportunity is accepted or not is a different matter. In many cases people might "argue back", seek "revenge", want to "get even", report the person to someone "in authority", talk about them to others, and so on.

If only these situations are accepted as the great learning opportunities they are, then great progress can be made instead of failing to learn by them and remaining static or even regressing.

If each such opportunity was acted upon, then great progress can be made on Earth and makes life much easier and more pleasurable.

So how can we learn these valuable lessons?

Well the Law of Attraction is always operating at all levels, in accordance with the Principle "like attracts".

Just as emotions attract, so do attitudes - they are all states of mind. And reveals what's in your heart.

How then can we apply this to everyday life?

Quite simply, everyone we encounter is an exact match for some aspect of our personality.

Knowing this, everyone we meet becomes a learning experience.

So next time you meet a person who "upsets" you in some way, for example you find them to be "greedy", or "egocentric" or "arrogant" – any trait at all - instead of reacting, look inwards and ask yourself "what aspect of that person was attracted to me?" Once you have the answer, which should be obvious, then resolve to immediately transmute that negative aspect of yourself into its polar opposite.

For example - if you meet a person who is greedy - mentally thank the person for the lesson they have offered - then resolve in future to take every opportunity to be generous. Donate to a charity for example, and generally give of yourself to others whenever possible.

If you meet a person who is "arrogant", "pompous" or "aloof", then resolve in future to act towards others only with humility. If you encounter someone who is aggressive, then resolve in future to always be gentle and kind towards others. And so on.

So you can see now how every personality is a reflection of some aspect of our own personality to some degree.

If every time you meet someone who invokes negative emotions in you by becoming the opposite positive emotion, not only are you evolving Spiritually, thereby fulfilling your purpose here on Earth, you will eventually reach the moment where your life is always harmonious, peaceful and tranquil, because you will have surrounded yourself with like-minded people.

The same can be said of every experience - all experiences are valuable lessons. Nothing ever happens by "chance". Such notions as "luck" and "chance" are nothing but superstitious notions of a humanity who does not understand who they are and why they are here.

So whenever you encounter a person or situation that invokes negative emotions in you, engage in immediate introspection to identify what aspect of your personality attracted the situation to you, and resolve to transmute it to its polar opposite positive attribute from that moment on. Do not leave it otherwise you continue to encounter negative people or situation until the lesson is learned and negative attribute transmuted.

It's as you will, it's in your hands!
