ARE YOU IN A WAITING PLACE

Bible Text: Psalm 27:14

Central Truth: When we wait on God, we put our hope and trust in Him, confident that He loves us and will keep us safe. And in that confidence, we find rest.

I'm sure you've read the eminent theologian, Theodore Geisel. He was a prolific writer for about half a century. Millions have read his books, and he's still read frequently. Name doesn't ring a bell? Oh, you probably know his pen name. Seuss, Doctor Seuss.

In one of his books, "Oh, the Places You'll Go", the Doctor writes about the Waiting Place. Read his words, and see if the place he describes doesn't sound familiar to you.

"Waiting for a train to go, or a bus to come, or a plane to go or the mail to arrive, or the rain to stop, or the phone to ring, or the snow to snow or waiting around for a Yes or a No, or waiting for hair to grow.

Everyone is just waiting. Waiting for the fish to bite, or waiting for wind to fly a kite, or waiting around for Friday night or waiting

perhaps, for their Uncle Henry, or a pot to boil, or a Better Break or a string of pearls, or a pair of pants, or a wig with braids, or Another Chance. Everyone is just waiting."

The Waiting Place - Yeah, you know it, don't you? The Doctor's been reading your diary, hasn't he? Some of us have season tickets for the Waiting Place. Earn points for Frequent Waiters. Maybe waiting characterizes your life. You wait for clarity of purpose. You wait for a better job. You wait for Someone Special, or Something More Exciting, or Somewhere Nicer. You wait for someone to give you a fair chance, or for someone to notice you. Maybe you wait for a cure, or a glimmer of hope, or forgiveness. Maybe you sit behind steel bars, day after day, waiting until the system says you've done your time.

Maybe you aren't a regular in the Waiting Place, but I bet you know it. You've been there, haven't you? If a doctor's ever told you, "We'll know in 72 hours," then you've been in the Waiting Place. You've been there if your company's ever been bought out and you've wondered if you'll be getting a paycheck a month from now. If you've ever struggled in a class, you know it. You've visited the Waiting Place if your body's ever broken down, if someone you trust has failed you, or if God has been silent.

If you've ever faced an outcome you couldn't foresee and couldn't control, you've been in the Waiting Place. It's not a pleasant place to be. You're forced to sit still, impotent, while circumstances swirl around you. Life, though it may go on, doesn't move forward. Too much is in doubt, too many questions unanswered, too many ends left loose.

If you're in the Waiting Place, the good news is that you aren't alone. Moses waited in the desert of Midian while forty years of his life slipped away before God called him to the work that we still remember him for. Job waited in dust and ashes for an end to or an explanation of his suffering. David waited for decades with only a promise that he'd be king while Saul chased him all over the desert. Peter waited by a seashore after his denial of Jesus.

Faith makes no promises that we'll be spared the Waiting Place. If anything, the Bible shows us that faith often brings us to the Waiting Place. People of faith are often left waiting while God's plan unfolds, or while He deals with sin in our lives, or while God prepares us for the road ahead, or while He clears the way for us. No, faith doesn't protect us from the Waiting Place. What faith does is to make us reconsider what -- or who -- we're waiting for -- And where we wait.

David wrote the song we know as Psalm 27 while threatened by his enemies. "The LORD is my light and my salvation -- so why should I be afraid?" he asks. The LORD protects me from danger -- so why should I tremble?" With that declaration of his confidence in God, David asks only one thing: "to live in the house of the LORD all the days of my life". For David, God's house is a place of delight, safety, joy, and peace. "My heart has heard you say, 'Come and talk with me,' and my heart responds, 'LORD, I am coming."" David pictures himself holding his head high, safely out of the reach of the enemies that surround him.

David's Waiting Place was God's house. When it looked like everything in his life was up in the air, he found refuge waiting in the shadow of the altar, protected in God's sanctuary. Waiting wasn't scary simply because of where he was waiting and Who he was waiting for. "I am confident that I will see the LORD's goodness," he said. "Be brave and courageous, and wait patiently for the LORD." And that's how faith deals with the Waiting Place. When we wait, we aren't waiting for Fate, or Luck, or Opportunity. We aren't waiting until we're strong or good or until we earn our way back. When we wait, we're waiting for God. We're waiting for His plan to unfold. We're waiting until He finishes what He's doing in us and deems it time for us to go on to the next thing. We're waiting for HIM. We don't have to be afraid; He loves us. We don't have to be anxious; He's in control. We wait upon Him, in His house, worshipping and drawing near to Him.

By the way, the word translated "wait" in this psalm means more than just sitting in one place marking time. It contains elements of hope and rest. When we wait on God, we put our hope and trust in Him, confident that He loves us and will keep us safe. And in that confidence, we find rest.

Isn't it just like God to turn the Waiting Place into a Place of Hope and Rest? Isn't it iust like God, who became human and experienced the Waiting Place Himself, to redeem even its dreary darkness? Isn't it iust like the God whose Son suffered at the Waiting Place of the cross and the tomb to turn even death into life? Next time you're in the Waiting Place, remember the cross. Remember an innocent body bleeding to give you forgiveness, hope, and a future. Get up out of your seat in the Waiting Place and move quietly and reverently into His sanctuary. Worship Him, delight in Him, and pour out your troubles and anxieties. Be brave and courageous, and wait patiently for the LORD.

THE SPIRIT OF LIBERTY

Bible Text: II Corinthians 3:17

Central Truth: We are therefore not only participants in the promising nature of God, but recipients of it!

Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. (II Corinthians 3:17)

In Robert Louis Stevenson's riveting Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde, a caring doctor drinks a poison and becomes monstrous. Tragically, in real life we've seen our children drink at the wrong fountains and turn back to us with their eyes forever changed.

But where the Spirit of the Lord is we don't need to worry about the kind of transformation that will take place — it'll be from death to life and then from glory to glory.

We've seen that in many lives, too, haven't we? Dead men walking with soulless eyes - changed! Happy pagans with no regard for God or man — changed! Spoiled and bratty children, self-centered wimps changed! Middle-aged men with hard, embittered spirits, as twisted in mind as in their aging bodies — changed! The selfcentered and cozy, who deliberately choose to pass by neighbors or a whole world in sin and misery — changed! The smug and self-righteous, clucking their tongues and prattling on about what the world's coming to — changed! The fiercely upright, scorching the earth but avoiding costly involvement — changed! And on rare occasions, whole cities, even countries are raised out of the muck and mire and are changed.

Let others say the changes are simply the result of psychology; human kindness, and

conditioning; fine literature, church services, new laws, or government leaders. Believers and rightly so, will insist that all of these are tools in the hands of the transforming Spirit, bringing life to the dead, passion to the indifferent, and generosity to the selfish. It is He who is at work convicting and sanctifying.

For the Christian, nothing less than the presence of the Spirit is enough to explain the marvelous changes worked in human lives. Call it grace; call it providence; call it the result of Bible study, practical involvement, or social ethics — call it what we will, just so we understand that behind all the instruments is the presence and work of the Spirit who seeks and finds and transforms.

This is the day, so say the Scriptures that this transforming work will embrace the whole creation, which presently groans in bondage. The curse will be obliterated; the creation will experience a glorious change along with the children of God. The Spirit of God is a sort of "firstfruits" of all that.

Where He is present there is a change from glory to glory! So let's take our places as God's children; we're intended for transformation. Our destination, our goal, is assured because the Agent of Change is at work making us more like Him!

God is in the transformation business. Through the Spirit, He doesn't just recover and reclaim us; He restores, revives, and renews. His focus is always on where we're headed, not where we've been.

STOP IDENTITY THEFT! (God's Way)

In recent years, there has been considerable concern over identity theft. Television news and special information programs have voiced concern. Credit card companies have placed fliers on identity theft in their monthly statements. Special protection plans and special services can be purchased to protect and supposedly monitor our credit identities to protect them from theft. Paper shredders are now much more in vogue as we become more and more aware of how important it is to destroy anything with our Social Security number and our other identity sensitive documentation.

In such a time, I believe it is also helpful for us as Believers to think about our identity and how desperately Satan is trying to help us lose it! He is the original master at identity theft. His desire is to make us doubt who we are and whose we are. He wants us to doubt our future and our citizenship. He wants us to question our ultimate victory because of our occasional failures. Most of all, he wants us to doubt the love of our Heavenly Father.

We see the evil one's ultimate desires when we see the demon-possessed man in Mark 5. One of the most striking realities of this whole story is the man's identity; we never know his name! Even though Jesus asks the man to give his name, he cannot. "Then Jesus asked, 'What is your name?' And the spirit replied, 'Legion, because there are many of us here inside this man." (vs. 9) Satan had effectively stripped the identity from the man as he isolated him to the place of death (the grave yard — vs. 2-3), caused him to inflict on himself bodily harm (cut himself and battered himself with stones vs. 5), and made the man uncontrollable (couldn't be bound with chains or shackles — vs. 3-4).

While we rarely see someone so completely controlled by the power of the evil one and his minions, Satan's intentions are still the same - identity loss, isolation, death, selfabuse, and loss of self-control. However, Jesus came to bring us deliverance every bit as real and powerful as the man in Mark 5 received from Jesus. Paul declares this deliverance God has brought for us when he writes the Christians in Colossae: "For he has rescued us from the one who rules in the kingdom of darkness, and he has brought us into the Kingdom of his dear Son." (Colossians 1:13) We shouldn't be surprised that Paul has already reminded these Christians that they are "God's holy people" and that they share in His inheritance (Colossians 1:2, 12). Deliverance from Satan's power means a new identity (cf. || Corinthians 5:17).

Satan's desire to make us doubt our identity and doubt the care of our God isn't anything knew. His attack on the first man and woman was focused specifically at the relationship Adam and Eve had with God (Genesis 3:1-5). As Jesus faced Satan in 40 days of temptation in the desert, the first words out of Satan's mouth were, "If you are the Son of God." Fortunately God had just prepared His Son for such an attack by declaring, "This is my Son, whom I love; in him I am well pleased." So we shouldn't be surprised that as Paul writes to new Christians in Thessalonica, he affirms their identity and their work in the Lord (I Thessalonians 1:1-4). When he later writes those who are struggling with their new identity and their old sinful way of life in Corinth, he does a very similar thing, reminding them of their precious and holy new identity in God

(I Corinthians 1:2-9). To those who live in the seat of the Roman Empire's authority, Paul reminded them of their relationship with God as Abba Father. As God's children, they were heirs of God — just like Jesus Christ, in whom they had a victory that Satan, death, nor anything else could steal from them. (Romans 8)

As I stated yesterday in the weekly inspirational message, we need to help each other remember our new identity and to encourage each other to live passionately as members of God's Kingdom of light (Hebrews 3:12-14). In this world, we may feel like strangers and exiles, but we are actually God's holy and special people called to live a life based on love and our new identity (I Peter 1:1-2, 13-16; I Peter 2:9-12). So in our current environment, when we will hear so much about identity theft, let's use that warning to be our own spiritual warning. We must not let Satan steal from us our passion for living out our new identity in Christ as God's holy, precious and victorious citizens.

Remember, our citizenship is a lock; jealously guarded by the Holy Spirit. Welcome to your new identity! Welcome Home!

THE VIRTUAL MANAGER

No office would be required, no benefits would have to be paid; and, for the most part, no business would have to be sacrificed. The Virtual Manager would arrange daily appointments/schedules, take phone calls, provide a messaging service, remind you of meetings and appointments, make calls to reschedule when conflicts do occur, and help you to keep your business and yourself organized to the degree that prevents you from appearing to be an amateur but allows you to present yourself as what you are – a professional.

JOB DESCRIPTION

In order to qualify for the position of a Virtual Manager, the potential candidate must possess the following qualities/characteristics:

- Have professional telephone etiquette. A Virtual Manager is a representative of the businesses employing his/her services. It is imperative that nothing is done or said to jeopardize the growth of that business due to lack of professionalism on the part of the Virtual Manager.

- Must be a good speller and write legibly. As a primary function of the Virtual Manager will be to serve as a messenger, it is important that names and numbers are taken down correctly and legibly. A Virtual Manager must know how to tactfully request the assistance of the potential client with the spelling of names and repetition of numbers to ensure that all information is relayed correctly.
- Must be able to type at least 50 words per minute. There may be occasions when the Virtual Manager has to take messages or prepare correspondences to be faxed or otherwise transmitted to the employers. During most business situations, time is of the essence, and when something is needed, it is needed right now. Speed and accuracy must go hand in hand, and the Virtual Manager must make sure that information is provided in a timely and proficient manner.
- Must manage time wisely. This holds true for the clerical/administrative responsibilities as well as for assisting your employer with scheduling his/her daily activities.
