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EMPOWERMENT! (The Presence of the Holy Spirit)



(John 14:25-26)

Central Truth: From that holy Pentecost Day until now, the principal proof of the Spirit's presence has not been fire and noise. It has been and remains and always will be changed lives that are being brought under the Spirit's control.

When you hear the term "Holy Spirit," what comes to mind? Do you think of Pentecost? Do you think of modern controversies over tongue-speaking? Do you visualize "tongues like fire" over the heads of the apostles? My concern is that most of us think of the Holy Spirit as a radiating power or influence rather than in personal terms a mysterious 'It' rather than a gracious Person. I suspect I know why we think that way.

In both Greek and English, "Spirit" is a neuter noun. And we think of a neuter noun as an "it" rather than a he or she. Thus we think of the Holy Trinity of orthodox theology in a peculiar way. God the Father we visualize in warm, personal terms. God the Word (i.e., Logos) we more often speak of as God the Son and think of personal images ranging from Bethlehem to Nazareth to Jerusalem. Not so, however, with the Holy Spirit. Both the neuter noun and the biblical images of fire and anointing tend us away from personal to impersonal imagery, from Spirit as divine personality to Spirit as divine emanation. How unfortunate.

The Spirit-Paraclete

In the Gospel of John, Jesus invites us to know about, expect, and experience the Holy Spirit. And He speaks of the third member of the divine family in terms that are personal. In fact, He challenged His original followers to think of the Holy Spirit in the same personal ways they had experienced Him. He has already told the apostles: "I have said these things to you while I am still with you. But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything, and remind you of all that I have said to you" (John 14:25-26). The Spirit would take Jesus' place in their midst both to "teach" and "remind" them of what had happened during His ministry.

In our text for today, Jesus returns to His promise of Holy Spirit presence, teaching, and guidance among those disciples. He told them:

"I did not say these things to you from the beginning, because I was with you. But now I am going to him who sent me; yet none of you asks me, 'Where are you going?' But because I have said these things to you, sorrow has filled your hearts. Nevertheless I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Advocate will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you. And when he comes, he will prove the world wrong about sin and righteousness and judgment: about sin, because they do not believe in me; about righteousness, because I am going to the Father and you will see me no longer; about judgment, because the ruler of this world has been condemned".

"I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth; for he will not speak on his own, but will speak whatever he hears, and he will declare to you the things that are to come. He will glorify me, because he will take what is mine and declare it to you. All that the Father has is mine. For this reason I said that he will take what is mine and declare it to you" (16:4b-15).

Notice what the version I am using calls the Holy Spirit in the two texts we have read. The New Revised Standard Version has Jesus calling Him "the Advocate" as opposed to the King James Version's "Comforter" or the New International Version's "Counselor." The original term in John's text is parakletos. Because of its background in court settings, I suspect "Comforter" is too passive a rendering. The Holy Spirit represents our interests, stands in for us, and goes to bat for us (cf. I John 2:1).

Getting a word for parakletos is not easy. I read how the Karre language of certain African tribes, for example, was proving to be particularly difficult for translators with this word. How could they describe the activity of the Holy Spirit to people without the sort of legal system developed countries know?

One day the translators saw a group of tribesmen going into the bush with bundles on their heads. They noticed there was one in the group who carried nothing, and they assumed he was the boss who was there to oversee the rest. To the contrary, they discovered his task was to be alert, see anyone about to fall from exhaustion, take up his load, and carry it for him. He was known in the Karre language as "the one who falls down beside us." The translators used that word to convey the work of the Holy Spirit in their rendering of the Gospel of John.

I think the apostles were overwhelmed and reeling with the thought that Jesus was about to leave them. As far back as 13:36 and 14:5, He had told them that He would not be with them much longer. They were supposed to carry on without Him? These

men who had been dependent on Jesus were supposed to go it alone now? That was enough to stagger them, all right!

So what does the text mean when it quotes Jesus saying, "But now I am going to him who sent me; yet none of you asks me, 'Where are you going?' " (v.5). Hadn't they asked? Hadn't Peter asked to go with Him? Hadn't they all been troubled by His announcement? Well, yes. So what did Jesus mean? It gets clear if you read the verse with an emphasis on one word: "But now I am going to him who sent me; yet none of you asks me, 'Where are YOU going?' " They had reacted to His earlier announcement with shock, concern, and confusion about what His departure meant for them (cf. v.6). Jesus' answer was to say that their fears could be diminished if they would ask what He was going to do in His absence. Abandon them? Forget about them? Hardly!

As soon as Jesus returned to heaven, He was going to send the Holy Spirit. That would be so Jesus assured them "to your advantage" (v.7b). How could the Spirit's presence be more helpful than Jesus' presence had been? Jesus could only be present with them at one place in any given moment, but the Holy Spirit presence would fill them all and simultaneously accompany each of them at every moment. There would be an advantage to God's presence with them through the Holy Spirit. He would be an ever-present Defense Advocate, Burden-Bearer, and Strength-Provider.

More specifically still, He would empower the apostles and the church they founded on Pentecost for its mission. "When he comes," said Jesus, "he will prove the world wrong about sin and righteousness and judgment" (16:8). In other words, the believer's Defense Counsel would become the unbelieving world's Prosecuting Attorney! As He would on Pentecost and in so many other settings, He would prove the world had sinned in its failure to receive Christ (16:9); that rejecting

Him in the name of its own self-serving righteousness had been wrong-headed (16:10); that it had placed itself under divine judgment with its unbelief (16:11).

Sure enough, when the Spirit came on that first Pentecost Day following resurrection of Jesus, He glorified Him as the Son of God and caused thousands to be pricked in their hearts, turn to Jesus, and be baptized in His name (Acts 2:36ff). And the same Holy Spirit has been doing that same redemptive work from that day until this one. I am a Christian because the continuing ministry of the gospel by the power of the Holy Spirit convicted me of my sin, showed me the impossibility of creating my own righteous path to God and made me sense the guilty verdict that had been pronounced on me. Then He glorified Christ before my eyes, convinced me that He was the only way to eternal life, and invited me to open my mind, heart and life to Him so I could be saved.

Asking in Jesus' Name

It isn't difficult to understand why the disciples were self-absorbed in their sadness and confusion over the looming departure of Jesus. If only they had been able to understand then what became clearer to them later!

"A little while, and you will no longer see me," Jesus said, "and again a little while, and you will see me" (16:16). If they had been bewildered before, think how they must have felt at hearing that. But you and I have the advantage of hindsight. Yes, He would vanish from their sight and to all appearances at least be swallowed up by death. But in a matter of a very little while, He would be back among them first in His resurrected presence and then in the presence and power of the Holy Spirit. And their anguish would turn to joy, as that of a woman giving birth through great pain (16:17-22).

And the nature of that joy? They would know that all of Jesus' claims were true, that Jesus had become their full access to the Father that His name would henceforth be their authorization to ask whatever they needed for the sake of the kingdom of God. During His earthly ministry, these men had seen Jesus as the one through whom they could learn of and have access to God. In the post-resurrection and post-Holy Spirit era, these disciples and their ever-widening circle (i.e., the church) would be part of the fellowship of eternal life that would mark a new beginning, a new era of partnership between heaven and earth. This is what I understand Him to have meant when He said, "On that day you will ask nothing of me. Very truly, I tell you, if you ask anything of the Father in my name, he will give it to you. Until now you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask and you will receive, so that your joy may be complete" (John 16:24-25).

That the interpretation I have offered of these words is correct seems supported by verses 26-28. After the resurrection, these disciples along with the rest of us who trust in Jesus would know that the love of God has been made flesh in Jesus and that we are invited to come before the throne of God boldly with all our needs (cf. Heb. 4:16).

"We understand now!" the disciples said. "We've got it, Jesus! You don't have to worry about us anymore now that you have been plainspoken and direct with us!" (cf. 16:29-30). Right! Sure! However, they would be scattered in a matter of hours cringing in fear and wondering if any of Jesus' claims had ever been true. They and their heirs in faith would later doubt Jesus' promises because of the persecution that came against them.

So what was Jesus promising as the basis for our joy? That nothing in the unpleasant circumstances we may have to endure in

this world can take away our eternal inheritance. That trouble, hardship, and death will never separate us from the love of God that we know in Christ. "In the world you face persecution," Jesus says. "But take courage; I have conquered the world" (16:33b). Thus His promise is that everyone who is in Him may rest secure in His settled peace of triumph over evil (16:33a). The same Holy Spirit who would raise Jesus from the dead was coming to dwell among His followers and will raise us up in the last day to share His triumph (cf. Rom. 1:4). Those in whom the Spirit dwells are as secure against the threats that would keep us from that destiny as Jesus Himself.

Is He Among Us?

People did not have the relationship with the Holy Spirit believers experience now prior to the resurrection and ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ. Oh, the Spirit had existed from eternity past with the Father and the Son. He had been active in creation and at other times in the history of heaven's dealings with humankind. He was certainly at work in the supernatural conception, miraculous signs, and brilliant teachings of the Son of Man. But late in the life and ministry of Jesus, we are told: "Now he said this about the Spirit, which believers in him were to receive; for as yet there was no Spirit, because Jesus was not yet glorified" (John 7:39). The indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit in human beings would be initiated only after Jesus arrived safely home at the right hand of the Father.

In his book Symbols of the Holy Spirit, Gordon Brownville tells about the Norwegian explorer Roald Amundsen. On one of his trips to the North Pole, Amundsen took a homing pigeon with him. When he had finally reached his destination at the top of the world, he opened the bird's cage and set it free. It takes very little imagination to see in your mind's eye the happy face of his wife when the pigeon cir-

cled the sky above their house and came to its resting place with her. In that moment, she knew her husband was alive and thinking of her. She knew he had reached his destination safely and would be returning to her shortly.

The ascension of Jesus was something on that order to the apostles. He had left them. They were anxious. They needed to know he had not forgotten them and would come back. That is why Pentecost was so joyous for them! They had waited in Jerusalem and held onto His promise in trusting prayer. Then the Spirit descended into their midst, and they knew they had not been forgotten. Jesus had arrived at the Father's right hand. In His victorious triumph over the world, He had guaranteed theirs by sending the Holy Spirit. And that is the abiding message of God the Holy Spirit in our midst. Nothing can separate those who are in Christ from the love of God, the presence of the Spirit, or the certain hope of eternal life.

Conclusion

From that holy Pentecost Day until now, the principal proof of the Spirit's presence has not been fire and noise. It has been and remains and always will be changed lives that are being brought under the Spirit's control.

When a man or woman is baptized in Jesus' name, that person receives the gift of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:38). His body becomes the temple of the Holy Spirit (I Cor. 6:19), and her mind begins to be renewed by the Spirit's presence (Rom. 12:2). Selfishness and greed get transformed into generosity. Lust gets purified into love. Anger, pride, and self-absorption are metamorphosed into a forgiving spirit, unpretentious behaviors, and captivation with Jesus Christ. The Holy Spirit within us moves us to worship, drives us to the Word of God, and stirs our consciences.

To believe in the Holy Spirit is to believe that the Living God is able and willing to enter human personalities to change them.

Christ sent the Holy Spirit to be in us. We are dead in our trespasses and sins. All the commandments and laws of heaven cannot bring us back to life. But we can be quickened and made alive by His indwelling presence born from above by the water of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is the living hand who works inside and through us. I want to be filled with His presence, animated by His power, and used for God's purposes in the world.

Come, Holy Spirit! Fill your church. Empower us as your people. Make us living witnesses to your illuminating presence in this world.

Jesus' Family Tree



(Luke 2:8-14)

Central Truth: The message of Jesus' family is this: no one need think that God will not accept them, because they're not good enough. God's grace is sufficient for everyone who comes and places their faith in Jesus.

How many of you, when you are reading the Bible, skip the "begets?" Come on, 'fess up'! Those endless lists of names may not be the most exciting parts of God's Word, but they're there for a reason. Now in the case of the genealogy recorded in the first six verses of the gospel of Matthew, we

have Matthew introducing Jesus to His Jewish audience in the proper Jewish fashion. You see, in those days, before people were interested in anything else, they were interested in who your father was, and who your father's father was and so on.

But I think Matthew had more in mind than just Jesus' proper intro to His Jewish audience. As you look at Jesus' ancestors, you are looking at the hand of God at work. From Abraham on down, God has rolled up His sleeves to insure that Jesus would come into the world. These genealogies, which we so often skip over, are really testimonies to the sovereign power of God. Each generation tells us a story of God's working, His caring, His thrusting into the lives of His people. Don't you feel bad about skipping them now? It's time you redeemed yourself by taking a look at just a few of these people with me! I'll try not to make it too painful.

The first person I want to bring to your attention is Tamar. Does anyone remember Tamar? She's a Sunday School teacher's nightmare. Talk about your proverbial skeleton in the family closet! She was a glowing example of pragmatism. Her motto was, "I will do whatever I have to in order to get the job done." Even if that involved pretending she was a prostitute in order to sleep with her father-in-law! (Read about her in Genesis 38:6) Tamar, certainly wasn't tame!

Next I want you to look at Rahab. It was bad enough that Tamar pretended to be a prostitute, but now we have the real thing. And to make matters worse, Rahab was not only a prostitute, she was also a Gentile. What was God thinking when He was putting together Jesus family tree? Couldn't He have worked through MORE RESPECTABLE PEOPLE?

Rahab may have been a prostitute, but when she heard about the God of Israel,

she knew He was the real thing and she responded. The rest of Jericho had the same news and the same opportunity, but she was the only one to take advantage of the opportunity. One person can be confronted with the reality of God and look the other way. Another person will see the mess they've made of their lives and turn to Him in faith. Rahab happily walked out of the rubble of sin, and hopelessness, and became an example of faith, and an instrument of God's grace. Rahab may have been a REPROBATE, but she was the only one who had the wisdom and faith to choose God's way!

Next, we have Ruth. She's another person you just don't expect to see in Jesus' family tree. I mean, she was a Moabite. She was from a people whom God had declared it was unlawful to marry. In other words, she was from the wrong side of the tracks and then some! A "good Jew" just wouldn't have married a Moabite. Right! Ruth may have been from the wrong side of the tracks, but her loyalty and her faith are inspiring. Ruth is a statement of God's grace. According to the letter of the Law, she shouldn't have even married a Jew. but her heart, her loyalty, and her faith, brought blessing for Naomi, and the entire world because she, too, is part of Jesus' family tree.

Finally we have "Uriah's wife." This is interesting. isn't it? Bathsheba isn't mentioned by name. She is described as the one who had been Uriah's wife. WHAT A WAY TO BE REMEMBERED! Could it be that Matthew didn't think she was worthy enough to be named? Perhaps he wanted to remind us of her sin? Regardless, God forgave David and Bathsheba the great sin they had committed, and blessed them with Solomon. David and Uriah's WIFE certainly caused God some serious issues, but that didn't stop Him from using her to bring us grace through JESUS' LIFE.

When you start to dig into Jesus family tree you find all kinds of skeletons in His closet. Why would God bring His Son through such a group? What's the point?

Well, think about it for a minute — even though I've mentioned only four of Jesus' ancestors, all of them were less than perfect, all of them had things in their lives they regretted, or at least things they should have regretted! The bottom line is that we were all sinners. But, more than that, Jesus is God's gift of grace to a world that needed most of all mercy and love. And, as the living, breathing, walking, serving, suffering, dying example of God's grace, it's only fitting that He came from a family already wondrously touched. directed, and redeemed by His grace.

The message of Jesus' family is this: no one need think that God will not accept them, because they're not good enough. God's grace is sufficient for everyone who comes and places their faith in Jesus. Not only will He accept them, but He will forgive their sins, touch their lives, change their hearts, and use them to bring forth His eternal purpose in this world. Just as He used Tamar, Rahab, Ruth, and Bathsheba.

And the angels said unto them, "Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, which is Christ the Lord. And this shall be a sign unto you; ye shall find a babe rapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger. And suddenly there was with the angels a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, goodwill toward men. (Luke 2:8-14, KJV)

Jesus is in every way, God's expression of "goodwill toward all men" regardless of what they have done, or where they're from. Praise God for this most wonderful and unexpected of all gifts, the gift of God's

grace through the birth, life, death, and resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ!

Well, while I was at the store, the electric company showed up. They turned the electricity off, cut the limbs out of the lines, and told my son, Michael that we would have to get an electrician out to connect the electric meter back to the house before they could turn the power back on. Giving by faith is meant by God to be an exciting privilege. When you honor and praise God through your commitment and obedience to stewardship, He showers you with joy. He turns your giving into a thrilling adventure in Christian living.

Understand Stewardship

To start on your journey to financial freedom, you first must understand the meaning and importance of stewardship.

In the New Testament, two different words describe a steward. One emphasizes guardianship over children and the administration of a master's household. The other stresses the role of a manager over property. In either case, a steward oversees the affairs and property of another person.

One cannot overemphasize the importance of stewardship. Stewardship over all that God entrusts to us in life is foundational to giving. All that we have, we enjoy because of God's grace and goodness. He has put into our hands the administration of all that He owns. As your preeminent master, He holds you accountable for how well you manage what He has entrusted to your care.

This divine perspective helps us understand much of our purpose for living as Christians. We are here to glorify God thorough the wise investment of our time, our talents and our treasure. Our Lord came to seek and to save the lost. He has commanded us to continue His mission by helping to fulfill the Great Commission in our generation.

My goal is to help you fulfill God's purpose for your life by showing you the biblical way to invest wisely in God's kingdom and thereby increase your fruitfulness for Christ.

Be Faithful

Faithfulness is another quality that will equip you to enjoy giving. The apostle Paul says, "It is required that those who have been given a trust must prove faithful." Faithfulness is dependability - a steady, day-by-day obedience to God in what He has given you to do.

A trustworthy steward will evaluate his opportunities and invest what God has given him in such a way that it will produce the best possible results.

Adopt a Godly Attitude

The attitude of a steward is vital. Paul admonishes "Let everyone give as his heart tells him, neither grudgingly nor under compulsion, for God loves the man whose heart is in his gift." Or as the Living Bible renders it, "Cheerful givers are the ones God prizes."

The Greek word translated "cheerful" is hilaros, from which we get the word "Hilarious." Supernatural, Holy Spirit-directed stewardship is giving with expectation, excitement, joy, praise - even laughter. Indeed, God prizes "hilarious givers" because they are the ones who have discovered the exciting enjoyment of giving.

Recognize and Fulfill Your Stewardship Responsibilities

One of the major responsibilities - and privileges - of a fruitful steward is to share the life-changing message of God's love and forgiveness through Jesus Christ. Our Lord has given to every Christian the command to "Go into all the world and preach the Good News to everyone, everywhere" and to "make disciples in all the nations." This command, which the church has historically called the Great Commission, is the privilege and duty of every man and woman in every generation who confesses Christ as Savior and Lord.

If you and I and Christians everywhere will simply obey our Lord's call to the stewardship of our time, talents and treasure, we will release not only vast sums of money to advance His kingdom, but all other resources needed to reach billions of people for Christ and thus help fulfill the Great Commission in this generation.

Matthew 6:21 records perhaps the simplest truth about your commitment:

"Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."

One can determine much about a Christian's spiritual life and how faithfully he fulfills his stewardship responsibilities by what he treasures. Your use of time, talent and money clearly shows your spiritual commitment because you invest in what your heart values most.

5 STEPS TO DEFEATING DEPRESSION AND ATTAINING A STATE OF PERFECT WELLBEING

I receive messages from all too many people who believe they are suffering from "depression", feelings of "hopelessness" or even "life is not worth living" often as a result of a 'perceived' lack of something in their experience.

The truth is that such feelings as worry, fear, and lack for example will create a self-fulfilling prophecy that can only result in more of the same - until alas sometimes a person will reach the stage where they feel that "life is not worth living anymore", often with an unhappy ending.

It does not matter how our life "seems", the important fact to grasp initially is that whatever we are experiencing now, we have attracted to us by our thoughts and actions - every single time - no exceptions.

It is absolutely crucial to accept responsibility for our 'perceived situation' and to never lay the blame on anyone else, or ascribe it to such notions as "chance", "bad luck" or "misfortune".

From the moment we arrive on planet earth and start our conscious thought process, even as a baby, we are creating our own reality.

So the very first thing to do is to accept responsibility for where you are in life. And if it's not where you want to be . . . realize you created your situation through wrongful thinking and actions. Here are the 5 steps to turning your situation around:

Step 1: As part of this important first step, apologize to God and yourself by saying "I am sorry". Sorry for creating the reality you are experiencing.

Step 2: The next step in turning your life around is to stop allowing negative thoughts.

Every time you sense a negative thought that is not consistent with your objectives immediately say "Negate . . . Negate . . . Negate" as many times as is necessary until the thought dissipates. It is better to say "Negate!" aloud, but saying it in your mind is adequate if you are among others.

Keep practicing this for as long as it takes to cancel all negative thoughts, or at least until you can cancel them instinctively.

Step 3: Next decide what you <u>do</u> want in life - this step is vital. When you have decided - write it down in the present tense in as much detail as possible, for example "I have a beautiful . . ." In fact, write down everything you desire and provide the date or year you wish to see it come to pass. At the end of your letter to God say "thank you God for

delivering these desires to me" or words to that effect. For those who have created personal 'Blood Covenant' revise them if necessary.

Step 4: Next start focusing on your desire as if you have it NOW! Take time each day, just before and after sleep is an excellent time, to get totally relaxed and play your desires in your mind like a movie with you as the central point of focus - never from a "third party" perspective. In other words, you are in the movie, not viewing the movie. At the end thank God and know that you have it Now! And then go about your daily routine. If ever a negative thought enters your mind, say "Negate, Negate, Negate" immediately.

Step 5: Search the Internet or catalogs for pictures that represent your desires . . . print them or cut them out of the paper. Get a large sheet of poster board and attach the pictures to the board - then place a picture of yourself in the center. Write under the pictures - "my new home", "my new car", "my exotic vacation" etc. and look at your board as often as possible – again particular just before or after sleep. This is called a "Vision Board".

Never attempt to decide how your desires will be delivered. Your own spirit and subconscious mind are infinitely powerful and communicate directly with the Holy Spirit; together they can bring any experience into your experience.

Know, beyond any doubt, that God can deliver your desires, because:

"For all these things do the nations of the world seek after: and your Father knoweth that ye have need of these things. But rather seek ye the kingdom of God; and all these things shall be added unto you. Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom". Luke 12:30-32

Realize God is within and know God is the Source of all there is. Know that God knows that you have "needs" in your physical experience.

Never look to the 'world system,' to supply your needs. Have true "Faith" in your connection with God and your intimate connectedness with all He created.

During the course of the day do things such as play your favorite music, release your favorite fragrances, look at happy inspiring photos etc... as well as your Vision Board." Will to feel unconditional love for everyone.

Follow these 5 steps and know that whatever experience you have created for yourself will turn around completely and you will know that there is nothing you cannot be, do or have.

Each situation you are presented with should be faced with complete confidence, always knowing that you are an immortal spiritual being, a son or daughter of God, made in His image and nothing can ever harm you.

MESSAGE TO AREA CHURCHES:

The Bible advises us to 'get Wisdom', and it also tells us that Wisdom is the principle thing. However, we are told that in all of our "getting" of Wisdom we should also get understanding. Knowledge is a very vital part of understanding. It is defined as 'general awareness or possession of information, facts, ideas, truths or principles.'
