Continuing Education Awards

All full band members are eligible to apply for advanced training stipends. These stipends provide a way for pipers, drummers, and dancers to participate in continuing education in the form of musical camps or clinics. The monetary amount of the awards will be up to \$500 each, to be used for tuition and expenses.

These stipends are based upon a merit system and are awarded without favoritism to band members who commit to continuing active band membership.

If you would like to apply for one of these stipends, please plan to attend a Boise Highlanders Board of Directors meeting to present your application in person. The application should consist of a brief written request that includes the following:

1. Contributions you have made to the band as a member.
2. The manner in which you feel that continuing education will further your contributions to the band.
3. An agreement to continue to be an active, participating band member for a period of at least one year following the award. If this condition cannot be met, it will be expected that the award money will be promptly returned to the band.
4. A copy of the application form for the camp or clinic you plan to attend.

You will be notified of approval by the Board within one week of your application.
