If you would like to help, drop donations off in the Gathering Area

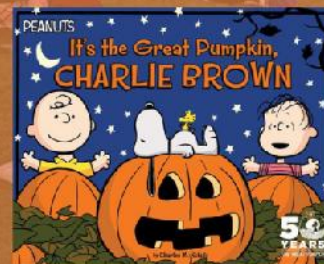
COMMUNITY MOVIE NIGHT
