Donations of bottled water and bags of individually wrapped candy are needed for the children If you would like to help, drop donations off in the Gathering Area

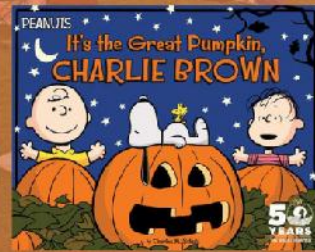
# COMMUNITY MOVIE NIGHT
