Community

Eagle Heights Christian Academy is a private, Christian school serving the educational needs of Pearland, TX and surrounding areas. Eagle Heights is located in the Pearland Independent School District which is a 43.5 square mile suburban area adjoining Houston's southern boundary. The total population in the district is over 100,000. The economic status is above-average living standards via a diverse mix of professional and industrial employment. Eagle Heights Christian Academy student body consists of a population that is 60% Caucasian, 18% Hispanic, 9% African American, 3% Asian, 5% Bi-racial, and 5% other.

School

Eagle Heights Christian Academy is a K-12th grade school enrolling 110 students in K-12 (enrollment intentionally reduced due to COVID-19). The high school enrollment in 2020-2021 is 17 students. The school opened in 1966 as a Kindergarten school. Over the years, it continued to grow and expand with the addition of a Pre-school and Mothers' Day Out Program. In 1993, first grade was added. Each year thereafter, a grade was added up through the eighth grade. In 2005-2006, high school was added, with its first graduating class in May 2008. For the 2012-2013 school year, EHCA had 4 seniors, all graduating with honors. In 2015-2016, EHCA had 2 seniors, one graduating with honors. In 2016-2017, Eagle Heights had 3 seniors, one graduating with Honors. In 2017-2018, there were 2 seniors, one with Honors. In 2019-2020, EHCA had 4 seniors, one with Honors. Eagle Heights is accredited by the **International Christian Accrediting Association**, recognized by the state of Texas through **Texas Private School Accreditation Commission (TEPSAC)** and through **AdvanceEd**. EHCA is a member of the Association of Christian Schools International and Oral Roberts University Educational Fellowship.

Curriculum

The **academic program** is equivalent in rigor and coursework to the Texas Recommended High School Program. The only distinction is that our students take 4 years of Bible as part of their elective requirement. Students take seven courses per semester with each class 50 minutes in length.

Honors classes are offered in all four years of English, Math, Science and Social Studies. Students are selected for Honors level based upon previous coursework achievement and standardized tests. Dual credit electives through San Jacinto College South are available to qualifying juniors and seniors. AP Testing is also available to students.

Students take the **IOWA Assessment Test and the PSAT** their Freshman and Sophomore years. EHCA requires students to take the **SAT Test** during both their Junior and Senior years.

Starting in 2016-2017, students in 8th grade take Algebra 1. High school students transition into a different 4-year plan for Math as these students move up.

Grade Point Average (GPA) and Class Rank

GPA is computed using the above quality points. Beginning with 9th grade, all subjects are included in the computation. Eighth Grade Algebra is also included in the computation. Grades and GPA are recorded on the transcript and GPA is computed in January and May.

Courses taken by tutor, homeschooling, correspondence courses, or summer courses are not considered. If a student transfers to EHCA during 9th-12th grade, only grades from an accredited high school recognized in the state of Texas are included in GPA calculations. Grades from homeschooling or a non-accredited private school are not included in GPA calculations. Approved dual credit classes are included.

Class Rank will be calculated only for the purpose of determining Valedictorian. EHCA is a non-ranking school for College Admissions Purposes.

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Post-High School Placement

Our first graduate in 2008 matriculated to a 2-year institution, Alvin Community College.

Of our two graduates in 2011, one matriculated to a 4-year university, University of Texas and one matriculated to a 2-year institution, San Jacinto Community College.

Of our five graduates in 2012, one matriculated to a 4-year university, Texas Southern University, two matriculated to a 2-year institution, Alvin Community College, and two chose to enter the workforce upon high school graduation.

Of our four graduates in 2013, one matriculated to a 4-year university, Texas Women's University, and three matriculated to a 2-year institution, San Jacinto Community College. All three have since graduated from 4-year universities (University of North Texas, University of Houston, and University of Houston at Clear Lake).

Of our two graduates in 2016, one attended a 2-year institution, Alvin Community College and has transferred to the University of Houston. The other attended a technical school in Knoxville, Tennessee, but has since returned home and has entered the workforce.

All three 2017 graduates were accepted to attend four-year universities. One is currently attending UCLA, one is attending the University of St. Thomas; and the third went to Alvin Community College the first semester but is now attending Rice University.

One 2018 graduate was accepted to Baylor but has chosen to attend San Jacinto College for her freshman year. The other graduate moved to Tennessee and is attending Volunteer State Community College. He will transfer to Tennessee Tech to complete his degree in Electrical Engineering.

Of our four graduates in 2020, two are attending the University of Houston.

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
