## TUESDAY: Let's PRAY

It is right to say that you can be responsible for your relationship and conversation with God. This week let's be FOCUSED on what is RIGHT and using our time to have a conversation with God.

## Wednesday: Let's READ MORE!

**Read Genesis 19:12-26:** The Angels told Lot and his family not to look behind them as they left the city. But at the end of verse 26, we read that Lot's wife looked back and turned into a pillar of salt. God gave specific instructions, Lot's wife disobeyed, & God chose to issue immediate and just consequences for her disobedience.

God is the same holy and just God today, as He was during the time of Lot and Uzzah. God does what He says He will do! He is Holy and all the laws surrounding the tabernacle and the ark were to remind the people of God's holiness and to help them see their own sinfulness in comparison with a holy God. It may seem tough that God killed Uzzah and Lot's wife but the people had forgotten God's holiness and their sinfulness and needed a reminder that God will punish sin. Lot's wife was told specific instructions and her choice led to her punishment. **Romans 6:23** says that the wages of sin is death. That tells us that the just and right punishment for sin is death. Thankfully at the end of the story we saw a window into God's plan of salvation through Jesus. In 2 Samuel 7:16, we see that God promised David that someone in His family line would be the forever King. Sin must be punished, but the FOREVER KING would come! Jesus came and died in our place and reigns forever now! **Read Hebrews 4:13, Isaiah 30:18, Deuteronomy 32:4**

## THURSDAY: WORSHIP TIME!

God is just, but the good news (gospel) is that He is also loving and gives us the chance to receive forgiveness through Jesus Christ. God is worthy of our praise and excitement and adoration because HE is right and just and good. Spend some time listening and singing to God today!

## FRIDAY: TIME FOR ACTION!

Find a new way to draw a picture to show that God is Just! You can draw a rainbow and explain that God does what is right and fulfills His promise. You could draw the story of Uzzah, Adam and Eve, or find your own way to illustrate your understanding. We must understand that we all sin and are in need of the salvation that God has offered. Now share your art with someone and explain that God is powerful and loving and **Just**.
