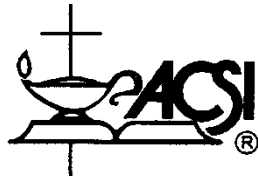

BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL

Children from Walnut Grove, Jackson, Burnette and McKendree Elementary Schools are welcome to attend the HCS Before and/or After School Programs. Children are dropped off and/or picked up at their school by the HCS Bus, with the exception of Walnut Grove that is serviced by public transportation. Children receive breakfast in the morning and a snack in the afternoon when they arrive. Activities include socializing with friends, working on homework, playing outside and inside centers and games.

No spaces will be assigned without a paid application and all required documentation on file.
