What does AWANA stand for? AWANA is derived from 2 Timothy 2:15, "Approved Workmen Are Not Ashamed." AWANA focuses on children and their ministry. AWANA and the AWANA Leaders will help youth understand the importance of sharing the "Good News" of the Gospel of Jesus Christ through the use of NIV scripture and AWANA Literature and GAMES!

There are five key principles that AWANA is based on:
