There is no greater joy than the birth of our Lord Jesus. The Word is incarnated in our midst. He is the Savior and Lord. When Mary received the message from the angel Gabriel, she learned that her cousin was expecting a baby, as well, and went to visit her. What is the significance of Mary's visit to her cousin Elizabeth before the birth of Jesus? When Elizabeth greeted Mary and recognized the Messiah in Mary's womb,, they were filled with the Holy Spirit and with a joyful anticipation of the fulfillment of God's promise to give a Savior. This visitation tells us that our God is God of all possibilities. What a marvelous wonder for God to fill not only Elizabeth's heart with His Holy Spirit but the child in her womb as well. John the Baptist, even before the birth of the Messiah, pointed to His coming and leaped for joy in the womb of his mother, as the Holy Spirit revealed to him the presence of the King to be born.

The Holy Spirit is God's gift to us to enable us to know and experience the indwelling presence of God and the power of His kingdom. The Holy Spirit is the way in which God reigns within each of us.

Jesus comes to us in so many ways, but without the Holy Spirit we are unable to recognize Him. But when the Holy Spirit enlightens us, we know the Spirit is present. The Spirit helps us see Him in creation, in the Eucharist, in our neighbor, in one another, in the poor, and suffering, and in the unborn who are like Jesus was at that moment in Mary's womb, entirely vulnerable, without voice to speak or cry out.

Let us give Jesus to others through our words and deeds.

The blessings of the Child Jesus and "Merry Christmas!"



In just over two weeks, I will join Bishops around the world in celebrating the Rite of Opening of the Jubilee Year at our Cathedral. Sunday, December 29,

I will celebrate the Rite of the Opening of the Jubilee Year in the various Churches at a

bi-lingual Mass beginning at 3:00 pm. In the preamble to the rite, #3 says, "The eucharist celebration takes the form of a stational Mass (cf. *Caeremoniale Episcoporum*, 120). All priests, therefore, concelebrate with the bishop; the deacons, acolytes, lectors and the other ministers carry out their proper service (cf. *Sacrosanctum Concilium, 26-28; Caeremoniale Episcoporum*, 119). It is important to ensure that summons reach all the faithful."
