To fellow members of FPC-C:

I would like to update you on the status of our current Stewardship Campaign for the budget for 2020. As of December 2, we have received 100 pledges (22 of which were new pledges!) for a total amount of \$469,492 or an average of \$4,695 per pledge. This puts us about 80% of the way to our goal pledge income for next year. While this is a very good start, there are still 42 pledging units (~\$155,200 in potential revenue) who made a commitment for the 2019 budget, but have not yet (as of today) responded to the 2020 budget campaign. I would encourage those who have not responded to prayerfully consider continuing your financial support of the church. If you intend to pledge, please submit your pledge card in next couple of weeks, so that we may finalize our 2020 Budget prior to year-end. I continue to pray (and hope that you do too) for the welfare and programs of our church.
